- p. 44b **601**. Most probably used by Guyot Angelin, tenant of the Saint-Quentin and the La Pielles mills (Troyes) [Le Clert (B163), p. 467].
- p. 45b **678, 683**. Attrib. to the 'Ban d'Ajol' mill (Plombières). FP = François Parisot, whose connections with the Duchesnes family are perhaps indicated by the acorns [Janot (B167), p. 425].
- p. 46a **609**. Var.: OLOT, ANOP, Reg. 131, 1423/9 [OVS].
- p. 48b **689**. Var. sim.: **Körös** (Hung.), 1460. Dl 35626 [IB].

776-8. Arms of Lindau [Sporhan-Krempel (B198)].
- p. 53a **Arc**. See Piccard (B34, p. 99) where 'similar' arc-marks with use-dates 1414 and 1515 are reproduced to demonstrate that similar marks might be used over a very long period.
779-807. *Zon.* 540 is an example of this type dated 1333.
- p. 53b **779**. This mark gave its name to Small Paper. Peter Drach in his *Rechnungsbuch*, ed. Geldner (*AfGB*, V (1964), cols 56-7) calls small paper *Arcus* to distinguish it from *Median* and *Regal* [AHS].

- p. 54b **801**. Le Clert (B163, p. 454) found similar marks from 1359 on (which he suggests are of Troyes origin) used by Colins dou paupier and his associates and successors at the Moulins-le Roi: Richard Bouvot, Silvestre Posche, and Gilet Le Pevrier.
- p. 57a **846-56**. Attrib. to the Braunau p-m. [FPM; Thiel (B125), p. 128]. Cf. AC, p. 444b, No. 8235.
853. Possibly attrib. to Lengfelden p-m. (papermakers Jakob and Sebastian Stallecker). B would in that case stand for Bergheim (near Lengfelden) [v. Hössle (B121); *Ein.* 89]. Cf. also No. 8777.
855. Possibly attrib. to mill at Lengfelden. P would in that case stand for Plain (near Lengfelden) [v. Hössle (B121); also *Ein.* 90].
 l. 27. For Salzburg read Braunau [FPM]. The Braunau mill was founded in 1520 [*Ein.*, p. 63].

 l. 5†. For Peter Ossendorf and family, and for the Benešov (Bensen) and Mimoň (Niemes) mills see Thiel (B116), p. 52.

- p. 58b **860**. Attrib. to mill at Gösgen [FPM].
 Last line. For No. 862 read 864 [HV].

- p. 59b l. 16. For Henri Reydhor see Ebenhöch (B309) [HV].
864. Dates from 1645-50 and shows the Solothurn (Solleure) escutcheon with crown and the initials VzM = Viktor zur Matt(en) of the Lower p-m. at Mümliswil [Ebenhöch (B309); HV].
- p. 60a **868**. The vertical line is probably a chain line; classed by M.-T. (No. 489) as a plain shield.
- p. 61b **869**. Shown reversed. Species common: four or five pairs in account books at Metz between 1448 and 1460. Running mark in Spencer-Rylands copy of Blockbook *Apo-*
