

- (B192) establishment data of 1519, based on taxation returns does not take this into account.
The initials S R in No. 2226 stand for Simon Ritz (†1601) of the mill at Freiburg i.B. (*for papier presumably read papetier*).
Nos. 2204-6, 2227-9 are Lorraine imitations; possibly also No. 2230. The latter in any case is *not* from Freiburg [GP].
- p. 166a 2243. Arms of Bruknar z Brukštejn, attrib. to one of the two mills at Libeň (near Prague). Variants of the mark without the shield and with mantling are found in 1570 and 1571 [Zuman (B133), p. 281].
- p. 166b l. 9↑. (Nos. 2254-5). *For* Freising sur l'Isar *read* Lauingen. Attrib. to the Schabringen (Zöschlingsweiler) mill. The lower coat in No. 2255 is that of Lauingen; the S = Sommer, the name of the papermaker; E Z = Emmanuel Zöschlin (b. 1578), the owner of the mill. The upper coat shows the arms of the Palatinate and Bavaria [Rückert (B236), pp. 13-14].
- p. 167b l. 14↑. Janot (B167, p. 321) points out that Br.'s remarks on Épinal stand in need of correction and supplementation.
l. 6↑. Janot (B167, p. 323) questions Br.'s statement that the 'Gouverneur' mill was situated 'en aval de la ville'; this would have been very unusual, as mills were generally situated up-stream of a town.
- p. 168a l. 2. There is no proof that an Anton Galliziani was a papermaker at Épinal [Piccard (B306), cols 117-18].
l. 5. Anthoine Rawellin (le petit Anthoine) was not the founder of the Épinal mill; he was the first master papermaker of the Grand-Meix mill at Docelles [Janot (B167), p. 210].
l. 12. The 'Poux' and the 'Grennevaut' mills were two different mills situated some 500 m. from each other [Janot (B167), p. 323].
- p. 170b 2276-8. Attrib. to ?Mühlhausen (Thuringia). See Weiss (B227). Cf. Nos. 913, 8421.
- p. 172a 2294-5. Arms of the town of Trutnov (Trautenau) in Bohemia and attrib. to the mill there. The mark represents a double-tower with a bird over the gateway, all above a dragon [Zuman (B140), pp. 7-8]. The mill was founded *ca* 1500 [Ein., p. 131].
2298-2302. Attrib. to Martin Schaffhirt's Wittenberg p-m. (1566 onwards) [Kühne (B233)].
- p. 173a l. 12. *For* 1440 *read* 1432 [WFT].
- p. 174a l. 4↑. The treasurer's accounts of the city of Fribourg for the year 1411 mention a payment for a ream of paper made 'a cillour de Praroman', but the first actual mention of the Marly mill so far located dates from 1474, when the Praromans sold it. When the family established or purchased the mill at Marly is still unknown [WFT].
- p. 177a l. 5. The Marly p-m. continued to function until 1921 and was therefore still operating at the time when *Les Filigranes* was published [WFT].
2324-5. Attrib. to the Prague mill [Zuman (B133, p. 282; B139)]. See also Ein., p. 127.
- l. 14↑. Zuman (B 133, p. 282) points out that the reference to the 'papierer' Claudio at Prague in 1517 does not necessarily imply local manufacture, but only trade. The earliest reference to a p-m. in the city dates from 1534.
l. 1-2↑. *For* Grzymata *read* Grzymała [AB].
- p. 177b 2337. Arms of Grzymała; attrib. to the Cistercians' mill at Mogiła near Cracow between 1586 and 1601 when Wawrzyniec Goślicki was abbot [Badecki (B271), p. 20; JSC].
2338. Arms of Grzymała; attrib. to the mill at Głowna near Poznań between 1600 and 1607 when Wawrzyniec Goślicki was bishop of Poznań [Budka (B281), p. 251].
2339-41. Arms of the Abbot of Siegburg and attrib. to the mill there [A. Schulte (B215), p. 48].
- p. 178a 2349. Attrib. to Nicolas Hullebin [Le Clert (B163), p. 344]. See, however, No. 9865 with similar initials 'Ph M' below, and 9868 attrib. by Le Clert (p. 397) to Philippe Maçon (or Masson).
- p. 178b 2356. Arms of Habdank attrib. to the mill at Mogiła near Cracow between 1552-86, when Marcin Białobrzewski was abbot of the Cistercian monastery there [Badecki (B271), p. 18; JSC].
2362-3. Probably a helmet (M.-T. 1793-6).
- p. 179a l. 15 (No. 2392). Of Troyes origin [Le Clert (B163), p. 456].
