

- confirmed; in Nos. 5015-17 the merchant's marks are much distorted; in Nos. 4979, 4980, 4987 not six, but five or four beads respectively, should show in the crown band [Piccard (*B100*), p. 10].
- p. 295b **4946.** The minuscule r indicates its provenance: Reutlingen [GP].
- 4949.** Definitely attrib. to Reutlingen [Piccard (*B100*), IV, 27].
- 5037-40.** Possibly attrib. to the Sirod p-m. Cf. *Br.* p. 469b.

- l. 81. **Croix grecque.** Add after 1501: (Nos. 5381-4 au centre de la feuille; No. 5387 pontuseaux irrégulièrement espacés) [Br. MS].
- p. 316b **5431.** Perhaps a minuscule 'f'? Cf. Nos. 8145-8 (which might be its majuscule form). Cf. also No. 16025.
- p. 318a **5468-71.** Perhaps represent a wheel [*M.-T.* 6923-30].
- p. 324a **5512-19.** No. 5512 is certainly attrib. to Freiburg im Breisgau. Nos. 5513-14 possibly so, but might be Alsatian. Nos. 5515-18 are certainly imitations of the above marks by mills in Alsace-Lorraine. No. 5517 is reproduced in reverse. The initials should read NvD and stand for Nikolaus von Dürckheim, who was a Strasbourg burgher [GP].
- p. 324b **5522.** The arms are those of Jacques de l'Engaine, an important paper merchant at Antwerp, through whom Plantin obtained the paper for his *Biblia polyglotta* (1569-73). He had probably dealt previously with Troyes, where he had paper made with his mark [Le Clert (*B163*), p. 99].
- p. 325a **5381-4.** All 'au centre de la feuille' [Br. MS].
