- p. 340a **5813**. Marks of this kind were in use at Troyes (Moulins-le-Roy) [Le Clert (*B163*), p. 460].
- p. 341b **5850**. Nicolas Boytote was a paper merchant at Troyes, having his paper made by the Nivelles, to whom he was related [Le Clert (*B163*), p. 277].
- p. 342a **5853**. Attrib. to Thomas Joly of Troyes [Le Clert (*B163*), p. 346].
5855-7. Attrib. to Claude Noël of Troyes (middle of the 16th c.) [Le Clert (*B163*), p. 417].
5863. Represents not a dolphin but a 'Gangfisch' or 'Gängfisch' and attrib. to the p-m. 'an der Kinzig' at Gengenbach (near Strasbourg) [Piccard (*B179*), cols 1000-1001].
