- p. 412b **7548**. A feature of Troyes marks is that the papermakers narrowed their chainspaces in the 1470s. This change is useful for rough dating. Here, for example, earlier spaces of 40 to 37 mm. have become 28 mm. by 1483. Cf. No. 1043: Écu de Troyes, No. 12484, etc. Around 1500 the chain-space is further narrowed to about 20 mm. These changes are very noticeable in the archives at Troyes as well as in printed books [AHS].

- p. 415a **7559-60**. Tentatively attrib. to the Gittelde mill in the West Harz. The initials may stand for 'Herzog Julius (Iulius) Hedwig' [Tacke (B195), p. 50].
