- Lettre V.** *Jl* mentions the occurrence of a mark possibly representing the letter U, placed between two chain lines, in a Gr. MS of 1311 (29 × 44 r.; MUNICH STAATSBIBL.: gr. 250); and of a similar mark in a Gr. MS of 1326 (30,5 × 44,5; SALAMANCA UNIV. LIBR.: M 31).

- p. 488a l. 7-9↑ (No. 9197). 1490 edition untraced: probably a misprint for 1494 (cf. No. 5753).
- p. 488b 9201. *Br.* never succeeded in finding this species of mark except in copies of *Speculum* III. Two examples occur in the Gemeente Archief at Haarlem, and similar marks appear in Boccaccio, *Genealogiae deorum* [1473], and suggest, with other marks of the Barrois, that the book was printed at Louvain rather than at Cologne. The mark is discussed on pp. \*22-\*23 and \*30-\*31. See also pl. \*C 11 [AHS]. The *Speculum* may be either *Camp.* 1569 or 1570, both datable to ca 1474.
- p. 489b **Lettres assemblées.** *M.-T.* group together letter-combinations which on grounds of style, etc. can be tentatively attributed to the same mill. *Jl* mentions the occurrence of the letters IM (or MI) in a Gr. MS of 1311 (29 × 44 r.; MUNICH STAATSBIBL.: gr. 250). It is the wm. cited by Keinz (see *Br.* p. IX) No. 368 and *M.-T.* No. 5763.

9319. A note in *Br.*'s working copy says that according to Dr K. Th. Weiss this wm. originates from the p-m. at Hillentrup, founded in 1584 by Dieter Cothmann, burgomaster of Lemgo. His sons sold the mill to the counts of Lippe in 1609. See also Weerth (*B199*). Cf. AC, p. 438a, No. 8119 and AC, p. 442b, No. 8233. The note 'Les deux C opposés ...' presumably refers to No. 9320.
- 9320-1. Janot (*B167*, p. 174) states that Wiener (*Br.* p. x) is wrong in attrib. these marks (with c-m. FA) to the Arches mill. They are in fact from the L'Isle mill (Cheniménil), papermaker Florentin Aubert. Janot failed to find this wm. in the 'Cptes de la Secrète' at Remiremont (Arch. des Vosges, G 1327). The note on Nos. 9320-1 is incorrectly entered under No. 9319.
