- 11351.** The initials may stand for Cardot Moussel, paper-maker at St Vincent on the Charentonne in Normandy in 1570 (cf. *Unicorns of Normandy*, in preparation) [AHS].
- 11356.** The initials very probably stand for Thomas Huet, who was making paper at Notre-Dame des Vieilles near Beaumont-le-Roger on the Risle in 1563. Normally in Norman Hand marks the thumb is on the left. Around 1630 the Huet family emigrated to the region of Morlaix and flourished as papermakers (cf. *Unicorns of Normandy*, in preparation) [AHS].
- 11358.** The initials may stand for Laurent Bellon, who was making paper at Canapville, south of Lisieux in Normandy, in 1564 (cf. *Unicorns of Normandy*, in preparation) [AHS].
- p. 574b **11386.** Cf. AC, p. 366a.
- p. 575a **11417 seq.** Attrib. to Nicolas Michelet of Troyes, the tenant of the Chaillouet and Vannes mills. After his death (before 1495) the mark became the property of his son-in-law Simon Havart († ca 1503), and, later, of Simon's son Claude († 1552) [Le Clerc (*B163*), p. 472–3].
- 11459.** The initial O is probably a deformation of the original 'LE' Clerc [Le Clerc (*B163*), p. 382].
- p. 576a **11417.** Br. lists no similar Hand in large format before 1504: No. 11435. Examples occur in J. Magni: *Sophologium* (Paris: Crantz, Gering, Fribourger, 1477), royal 4° (BMC, VIII. 9) [AHS].
- p. 578a **11449.** Le Clerc (*B163*, p. 377) attrib. a similar mark (Troyes, 1556) to Nicolas Le Bé (I) of Troyes.

- p. 579a **11522.** Regarding Br.'s doubts about a mark of apparently French origin found in a Venetian incunable, Le Clerc (*B163*, p. 474) points out that the Venetian printer Nicolas Jenson was a native of Sommevoire in Haute Marne.
- p. 579b l. 1–2. For (Nos. 11544 et 11545) presumably read (Nos. 11545 et 11546).
- p. 581b l. 11–13. 1486 edition untraced: there is one of 1487 (*Cop. 2983*).

- p. 585b **11617.** Represents a certain Noël and Innocent de Garoys of Troyes [Le Clerc (*B163*), p. 301].
- Marteau.** M.-T. (p. 154b) suggest that Br. 14073 represents the most ancient form of this mark.
- Last line (No. 11622). Perhaps used by a Troyes paper-maker [Le Clerc (*B163*), p. 462].
- p. 586b **11632.** Var.: VIC, CF, Man. Artigues, 1420–3 [OVS].
- 11638.** Var.: VIC, CF, Man. P. Artigues, 1435; Man. Poquí, 1436; Man. Franch, 1448; Man. Sallés, 1460 [OVS].
- p. 587a **11641.** Classed under 'miroir' by M.-T.
- Millésimes.** Add: 1566? No. 14072. See also *B102*.
- p. 588a **Monts, montagnes ou collines.** M.-T. (p. 155a) stress the close resemblance between early examples of this mark and a simple type of crown and suggest that the common original may have been a mitre. They class marks of this kind with more or less sharp points under 'couronne'.

- 11943.** Tentatively attrib. to S. Germany [Thiel (*B116*), p. 20].
- 11948–51.** Attrib. to Kaufbeuren [Thiel (*B116*), p. 20].
