The double-tower, however, already disappears before 1400, to return after 1540 (for a short while also around 1504). From about the beginning of the 18th c. the towers completely disappear as wms of the Ravensburg mills [Sporhan-Krempel (*B212*) pp. 59, 60, 66]. Cf. also AC, p. 762a, Nos. 15228-69.  
**15919-22**. Sporhan-Krempel (*B212*) gives the earliest use-date of this type of mark as 1536.  
l. 13↑ (No. **15961**). Arms of Offenburg (not Ravensburg). Cf. Nos. 15973-4 [GP].
